

When a new regulation, ingredient restriction, or new requirement is introduced, some of your products may be impacted.

When one of your products is identified as potentially affected, you will receive an email notification informing you that the product has been added to the list of **impacted products** in MyApps.

Monitoring topics will appear in MyApps only if a product from your company is impacted by the future change.

MyApps allows you to easily identify the affected products and indicate how you plan to manage them.

Follow the steps below to review and update your products.

Step 1: Open the Impacted Products list

1. Log In to your MyApps account

2. In the top navigation ribbon, Navigate to All my impacted products

Step 2: Review the information provided

1. Click on the product name in the list

The table contains several columns explaining the impact.

Component

The first column indicates which ingredient or component of the product composition is affected.

Example: the INCI "PARFUM"

Monitoring Topic

The third column contains the Monitoring Topic.

Click on the Monitoring Topic highlighted. This opens a detailed page explaining:

- the upcoming change
- the scope of the restriction
- the applicable deadlines
- the compliance requirements

Biorius Advice

The fifth column displays Biorius advice.

This section explains what is required for the product to comply with the topic of concern.

Examples may include, but are not limited to:

- confirming ingredient concentration
- updating the formulation
- updating the product label
- providing additional documentation

Step 3: Select an Action for the product

1. Click Take Action

You will be asked to choose one of the following options:

- Product will be brought into compliance and kept on the/this market
- Product will be withdrawn by the application deadline
- Product already discontinued on this market

This regulation implements new restrictions on certain substances, including **HEXYL SALICYLATE**, which is a commonly used fragrance ingredient. Please find below the list of products containing PARFUM/AROMA, which may potentially contain HEXYL SALICYLATE in their fragrance composition. We recommend you contact your fragrance suppliers as soon as possible to confirm the presence of this substance and to ensure compliance with the upcoming Regulation.

Option 1

Product will be brought into compliance and kept on the/this market

Select this option if the product will be updated to comply with the new requirements.

This may involve:

- formula adjustments
- labeling updates
- documentation updates

Your Biorius Manager will contact you to support the compliance process.

Use the “Reason” box for additional information

A “Reason” box is available in the form. We encourage you to use this field whenever relevant to provide additional information about your product or your decision.

For example, if a product is notified in both the EU and the UK, but the monitoring topic only applies to the EU, selecting “Product already discontinued on this market” will by default lead us to denotify the product only from the EU. If the product is also discontinued in the UK, you can specify this in the Reason box.

You can also use this field to provide helpful details, such as the function of an ingredient when requested in the Biorius advice, or any clarification that may help us process your request.

Option 2

Product will be withdrawn by the application deadline

Select this option if the product will be discontinued and removed from the concerned market before the applicable deadline.

Biorius will then:

- denotify the product from the relevant market by the applicable deadline
- deactivate the product in MyApps, when applicable

Option 3

Product already discontinued on this market

Select this option if the product:

- is no longer manufactured
- is no longer supplied to distributors or retailers from the concerned territory

Biorius will then:

- denotify the product from the relevant market by the applicable deadline
- deactivate the product in MyApps, when applicable

Step 4: Confirm your choice

After selecting the appropriate option

1. Click Confirm in the bottom right corner of the window

Your decision will then be recorded in the system.

If a product has multiple monitoring topics

Some products may be impacted by more than one regulatory change.

In this case:

1. Click Take Action
2. Select the monitoring topic you want to manage from the list on the left of the screen
3. Choose the appropriate option
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 if needed
5. Click Confirm
